The Outpatient Department, known as The Shepherd Program, at St. Mary's Home for Children was established in 1985 to provide outpatient treatment and support to survivors of sexual abuse and their families. Since then, the Outpatient Department has expanded its services to best support families impacted by sexual abuse, sexual exploitation and other trauma, such as family violence and physical abuse, through a myriad of programs. Treatment is available for children, adults and families and is provided in the office and community. Referrals for our services come from DCYF, physicians, families, schools, courts, other service providers and individuals seeking support and mental health treatment.

We offer professional consultation to agencies and individual providers regarding the treatment of trauma. We offer trainings for professionals as well as caregivers of those impacted by trauma.
