



Outpatient Services – Community Based Clinician

The Outpatient Department at St. Mary's Home for Children was established in 1985 to provide outpatient treatment and support to survivors of sexual abuse and their families. Since then, the Outpatient Department has expanded its services to best support families impacted by sexual abuse, sexual exploitation and other trauma, such as family violence and physical abuse, through a myriad of programs. Treatment is available for children, adults and families. Services are provided in the office and community.

We are currently hiring Clinicians, with experience in providing treatment to children, teens and adults who have experienced sexual abuse and/or sexual exploitation, both in the office and in the community with services ranges in intensity. This is a salaried position.

Qualifications: Clinical candidates must have a Master of Social Work Degree or equivalent Counseling Degree, State Licensure preferred or License eligible with plan to obtain, as well as experience working with children and families affected by sexual abuse/trauma, and home based service experience.
