The CBS Clinician will provide individual, family, and group therapy to identified families as well as participate in state-wide advocacy efforts. Schedule is flexible.

Qualifications: Experience providing home-based services with children and families preferred; experience working with survivors of trauma preferred; Clinical candidates must have a Master of Social Work Degree or equivalent Counseling Degree, State Licensure preferred or License eligible with plan to obtain, and a valid driver's license.
