Responsibilities and duties for SMHFC Clinician:

- The clinician works with a care coordinator to provide intensive, community based services to children, teens and families impacted by trauma.
- This is a state-wide community/home based program.

- The overriding goal of the service is to keep victims safe in their homes and communities and reduce the risk of re-victimization.
- The Clinicians and Care Coordinators work together to provide therapeutic, educational and social support to the survivor, psycho-education and clinical support to the parent or caregiver and work within a team model based on a multidisciplinary approach.
- The Community Based Services Clinician will provide individual, family, and group therapy to identified families as well as participate in state-wide advocacy efforts. Schedule is flexible.

Qualifications for Clinicians: Experience providing home-based services with children and families preferred; experience working with survivors of trauma preferred; Clinical candidates must have a Master of Social Work Degree or equivalent Counseling Degree, State Licensure preferred or License eligible with plan to obtain, and a valid driver's license.
